Dear SummitCare Family and Friends,

As part of our regular communications we would like to keep you informed of our long term future planning.

As part of SummitCare's long history in the Residential Aged Care sector and our ongoing commitment to Residents and Families we constantly assess each of our centres to ensure that we remain up to date for future standards.

We realise that modern trends in Residential Aged Care have for some time been moving towards single and twin rooms with ensuite bathrooms and in order to be prepared for future requirements we will submit plans to allow us to gradually upgrade or rebuild our centres.

In the past 6 months we have commenced a project in each of our older homes to remove beds from larger shared rooms and create more twins and single rooms thus allowing more space for each of our residents.

Additionally, we are working with our Architects on the design of new state of the art facilities at these same locations and plan to build newer buildings and facilities that will provide for the needs of each of our local communities. Plans include mostly single rooms with ensuites, coffee shops, cinemas, lounge and entertainment space, beautiful garden areas and therapy rooms.

We also have two new sites that are currently vacant blocks of land where we hope to build new homes.

To successfully design and build these projects takes time, possibly the next 3-5 years. We want to assure you all that we have a Master plan in place and no one will be inconvenienced.

Over the coming months you may see local Council notifications of our Development Applications posted in the front of your homes; Please be assured this part of the planning process and may take many months prior to approval and then many more in preparation for construction to begin.

This will be an exciting time for the SummitCare family into the future.
